Alien Medical Programs (AMP)

- Alien Emergency Medical (AEM)
- Long Term Care Non-Citizen Program
- Available to clients that haven't met the 5-year bar, "non-qualified aliens", and undocumented individuals.
- Clients must not be eligible for any other Medicaid program.

Alien Emergency Medical (AEM)

- To qualify for AEM, an individual must have or need at least one of the following:
 - *A qualifying emergent medical condition such as emergency room care, inpatient admission, or outpatient surgery*
 - *A cancer treatment plan*
 - *Dialysis treatment*
 - *Antirejection medication for a post-organ transplant*
 - *On long-term care services (LTC)*

Long Term Care Non-Citizen Medicaid

- Available to clients that are:
 - *Age 19 and over*
 - *Assessed in CARE to meeting NFLOC*
 - *Aren't eligible for any other federally or state funded Medicaid programs because of their citizenship status*
 - *NGMA approval for clients under 65*

Available Services

- Available services in this program include:
 - *Personal care services in a client's own home or a licensed residential setting*
 - *Nurse delegation in an AFH or ARC*
 - *Skilled Nursing Facility services*
 - *Services identified in Column CN 21+ in **WAC 182-501-0060** and **182-501-0065***

Ineligible Services

- Long Term Care Non-Citizen clients are not eligible for CFC services, including:
 - Meaningful Day
 - Specialized Dementia Care Program
 - Specialized Behavior Support
 - Expanded Community Services
 - Any other service covered by Residential Waivers or Community First Choice (CFC)

Qualified Providers

- *Clients choosing to live in their own home may select from the following qualified provider types:*
 - Individual Provider (IP)
 - Home Care Agency (HCA)

- *Clients choosing to live in a residential setting may select from the following qualified provider types:*
 - Skilled Nursing Facility
 - Adult Family Home (AFH)
 - Adult Residential Care (ARC) facility
 - Enhanced Adult Residential Care (EARC) facility
 - Assisted Living

Placement on the Program

45 Spots

- Spots are continuously filled as opening become available.
 - Clients selected from a waitlist to fill vacant spots.
 - No time limit to amount of time clients can receive services.
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Mental Health
Transformation

- 10 spots for clients residing at state hospitals.
 - Spots are continuously filled
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Acute Care

- 49 spots available for clients residing at acute care hospitals
 - Client must be in an acute care of ICU bed.
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Waitlist

- For waitlist placement, please provide the following:
 - ✓ *Client's Name*
 - ✓ *Client ID (if available)*
 - ✓ *ProviderOne Number (if available)*
 - ✓ *Date of Birth*
 - ✓ *Current residence and address*
 - ✓ *Client or representative contact information*
 - ✓ *Primary diagnoses or care services required*
- Functional and financial eligibility should be determined prior to waitlist request.

Authorizations

Care Plan

- Select “State Funded LTC for Non-Citizens” in the Care Plan Screen

RAC

- RAC 3340 – LTC for Non-citizen – In home
- RAC 3341 – LTC for Non-Citizen - Residential
- RAC 3342 – LTC for Non-Citizen – Nursing Home

Coverage Group

- L04 – Non-Citizen CN SSI Related Long Term Care
- L24 - Alien Long Term Care HCB Waiver

Medical Care Services (MCS)

- MCS is a state funded Medicaid program with limited services.
 - Clients are not eligible for waiver services.
 - Once a client is eligible for MCS, they are no longer eligible for the LTC Non-Citizen Program.
 - Clients that are active or eligible for A01 or A05 are covered under MCS.
- To be eligible for MCS, clients must be:
 1. Immigrants in their 5-year Medicaid bar or lawfully present non-citizens not subject to the 5-year bar (previously known as PRUCOL); and
 2. Eligible for aged, blind disabled (ABD) cash program or housing and essential needs (HEN) program; and
 3. Determined functionally eligible for MPC or CFC; and
 4. Determined to be financially ineligible for CFC or MPC because of their citizenship status.

Medical Care Services (MCS)

Eligible Services

- Skilled Nursing Facility services
- Personal care services in a residential setting
- Nurse delegation in an AFH or ARC

Eligible Settings

- Skilled Nursing Facilities
- Adult Family Homes
- Adult Residential Care Facilities
